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THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- ~ Injections – Hepatitis, Tetanus. Consult your doctor. No Malaria in our area except when traveling to the eastern parts of South Africa. (Kruger National Park)
- ~ Register your guns and valuable equipment (Cameras , Binoculars) with US Customs and get a form 4457 (No semi or automatic guns)
- ~ Fill in attached form (SAP 520). Do not sign it. Only sign it in front of the officer at Johannesburg International Airport (O R Tambo) when claiming your guns.
- ~ Guns and ammo: 60 rounds per gun would be enough. No rifles of the same caliber per person.
- ~ Pack ammo separate from guns, in original factory boxes.
- ~ Payment method: wire transfer, credit card (visa or master) no American express or discovery. Cash and checks.
- ~ Notify your bank and credit card company that you will be traveling abroad so they won't suspect foreign transactions made with your credit card.
- ~ Know your credit card pin number, if you want to draw cash from an ATM

- ~ Travel insurance: www.medjetassistance.com or www.sportsmanstravelinsurance.com
- ~ Insurance on guns and equipment: www.siaj or www.tic.com
- ~ Passport. Check your expiration date. And you need two blank consecutive pages in it for South Africa stamps. Make copies of your passport for in case it gets lost.
- ~ Plane tickets: Try the following travel agent

- ~ If you don't want to stand in line to register your guns in South Africa. I highly recommend that you get all copies of rifle paperwork mail to me in time.
- ~ Binoculars
- ~ Cameras – remember spare batteries. We do have converters in every room.
- ~ Toiletries, hairdryers is in every room, don't bring it with.
- ~ Medicine & Prescriptions
- ~ Hunting boots – 2 pairs well worn
- ~ Hunting clothes – 3 pairs, Cammo's are allowed in South Africa. If you like to wear shorts those zip-off pants are perfect
- ~ Casual wear for around the campfire.

- ~ 2 Jackets. The best is to put on layers and take them off when it heat up during the day. Mornings and evenings are cool.
- ~ Gloves.
- ~ Have your Outfitters address, Invitation and Information forms with you on the plane. You will need it to fill out immigration form upon arrival in South Africa.
